Cannon Cognitive: the cannon set a tangible theme and thus spur dramatic play. Dramatic play supports language and communication skills.





### Track Ride

Physical: train arm and core muscles. Bone density when jumping down from the handholds and motor skills like agility, balance and coordination are supported. Social-Emotional: cooperation, consideration, turntaking, risk-taking, self-confidence.

### Double slide

Physical: sliding develops spatial awareness and a sense of balance. Furthermore, the core muscles are trained when sitting upright going down. Social-Emotional: invites socializing, supports parent-child and peer-to-peer play. Cognitive: young children train their understanding of space, speed and distances when sliding down quickly.



Rock climber Physical: supports cross coordination and leg, arm and hand strength. Social-Emotional: the inclination makes climbing feel secure, especially for younger children.



Treasure box Cognitive: object permanence: hiding objects and finding them again. Spurs exploration and dramatic play, stimulating conversations.



#### Slime door

Physical: tactile stimulation from moving the body through the rubber slime door. Social-Emotional: stimulates turn-taking. Cognitive: the slime door encourages hide-and-seek or peek a boo games that trains the understanding of object permanence in toddlers.



### Window

Social-Emotional: invites interaction between sides and cooperative play.





