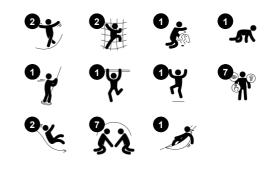

Pikes Peak amazes and delights children and families with its richly varied physical and social play activities. Kids will stay longer and come again to try out the many play options. The accessible stairway adds an easier opportunity for entry to elevated level. The climbing rungs add a harder cross-coordination task. The meandering activities have both wilder and

milder slides and glides. The dare-devil Fireman's Pole is really thrilling. Additionally, it trains the child's spatial awareness. This is fundamental in negotiating space securely. Sliding, apart from being great fun, develops children's trunk stability and sense of balance. This is important to the confidence in moving and the ability to sit still on a chair. The tunnel

motivates crawling, which develops cross-coordination. This supports brain coordination important for reading.



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Somersault bar

Physical: develop balance and core when hanging from knees. Arm, leg and core muscles are developed when climbing up, somersaulting around. Balance and spatial awareness are strengthened. Social-Emotional: meeting, socializing and turntaking when climbing up and down via bar.









Social-Emotional: inspires communication and turn-taking skills. Cognitive: distortion of sound evokes curiosity and stimulates an understanding of cause and effect.









Physical: sliding develops spatial awareness and a sense of balance. Furthermore, the core muscles are trained when sitting upright going down. Social-Emotional: empathy stimulated by turn-taking.



Hammock

Physical: coordination and sense of balance when swaying. **Social-Emotional:** meeting, pushing friends gently back and forth, turntaking.



Physical: the children crawl through the tunnel, developing motor skills such as cross-body coordination and proprioception. Social-Emotional: turn-taking when passing each other.



Fireman's pole

Physical: coordination is supported when going down, as well as arm and core muscles. Landing strengthens bone density, which is built for life in early childhood. Social-Emotional: turn-taking and risk-taking.





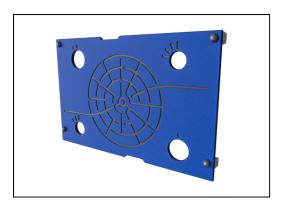
Binoculars

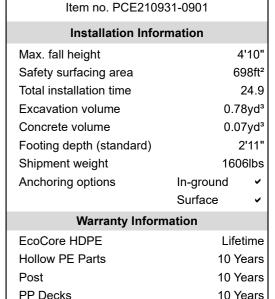

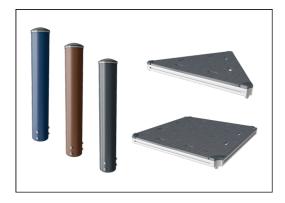


The ELEMENTS roofs are made of recyclable PE made from 33% post consumer recycled materials with a minimum wall thickness of 5 mm to ensure high durability in all climates around the world. The steel pipes are hot dip galvanised inside and outside for maximum durability.



Sails of commercial 95 high density PE knitted specially for sun-shade structures. The sails are treated with UV stabilizers to ensure a long lifetime. The sails are supported by a hot dip galvanized steel frame and tightened by stainless steel devices.





The main posts are made of high quality pregalvanized steel with powder coated top finish. Post tops are closed with caps of UV stabilized nylon (PA6). The grey colored molded decks are made of 75% post-consumer waste PP material with a non-skid pattern and texture surface. All decks are supported by unique designed low-carbon aluminum profiles with multiple attachment options.



The slides are available in either molded PE in different colors or in full stainless steel AlSl304 t= 2mm.



All steel activities has a unique surface treatment of hot dip galvanized base and powder coated top finish to provide durable products with long lifetime for all environments.

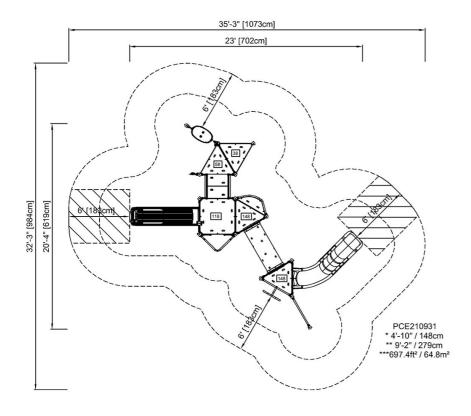


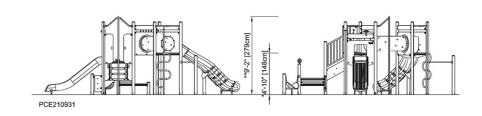
