

This fantastic play tower will attract children and encourage active and challenging physical play. The net bridge and climber provides challenging age-appropriate access to the structure that strengthens muscles and supports the development of crosscoordination. These skills are important for health and well-being as well as for thinking and learning. For example, using both sides of your body to climb stimulates both sides of the brain, essential for learning, particularly for literacy. The net bridge provides thrill and excitement that will enrich the play. Sliding down the slide or the Fireman's Pole supports posture and balance, all important skills for young children, and great fun! The play panels under the structure add two additional play spaces, enabling children to add cognitive and enhanced social elements to their play. The desk at ground level provides opportunities for children to come together and socialise in their creative play.

Net bridge, inclined Physical: walking the open net up or downwards develops balance, spatial awareness and cross coordination. Social-Emotional: interaction with children outside, socializing. Cooperation and consideration, e.g. when passing others.





Sand scoops panel

Physical: hand eye coordination and pushpull movements. Social-Emotional: invites cooperation due to the two-sidedness and provides for parallel play. Cognitive: logical thinking: cause and effect understanding when running scoops in grooves or shifting materials from scoop to scoop. Creative: shifting scoops, creating new scoop positions.



Slide

Physical: sliding develops spatial awareness and a sense of balance. Furthermore, the core muscles are trained when sitting upright going down. Social-Emotional: empathy stimulated by turn-taking. Cognitive: young children develop their understanding of space, speed and distances when sliding down quickly.



Rock climber Physical: supports cross coordination and leg, arm and hand strength. Social-Emotional: the inclination makes climbing feel secure, especially for younger children.

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Balcony

Social-Emotional: the balcony invites meetings and interaction with people on ground level. **Cognitive:** invites dramatic play and performance, which stimulates language development.



Climbing net

Physical: children develop cross-body coordination and muscle strength when climbing. The big meshes allow for climbing and crawling through, supporting proprioception and spatial awareness. Social-Emotional: the big meshes allow for more children to sit together and talk.


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Fireman's pole

Physical: coordination is supported when going down, as well as arm and core muscles. Landing strengthens bone density, which is built for life in early childhood. Social-Emotional: turn-taking and risk-taking. Cognitive: young children develop their understanding of space, speed and distances when gliding down fast.




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Panels of 19mm EcoCore[™]. EcoCore[™] is a highly durable, eco friendly material, which is not only recyclable after use, but is also produced from +95% recycled post consumer material from food packing waste. Wooden panels of impregnated and brown painted pine wood with vertical steel profiles.



Main posts with hot dip galvanized steel footing are available in different materials: Pressure impregnated pine wood posts. Pre-galvanized inside and outside with powder coated top finish steel posts. Lead free aluminum with color anodized top finish. Greenline TexMade posts of 95% post-consumer recycled PE and textile waste.



All decks are supported by unique designed low-carbon aluminum profiles with multiple attachment options. The grey colored molded decks are made of 75% post-consumer waste PP material with a non-skid pattern and texture surface.

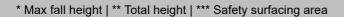

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


