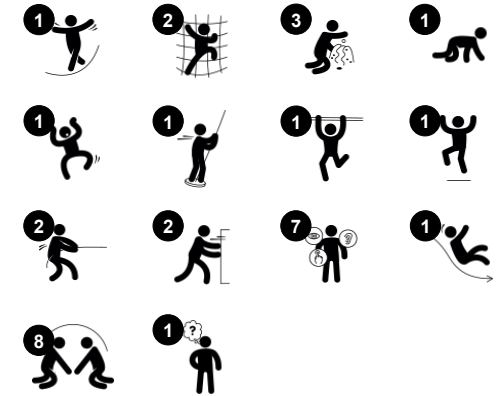

## Flower panel

**Social-Emotional:** invites cooperation due to the two-sidedness and provides for parallel play. **Cognitive:** suggests a theme and supports dramatic play, which stimulates language and communication skills.



## Slide

**Physical:** sliding develops spatial awareness and a sense of balance. Furthermore, the core muscles are trained when sitting upright going down. **Social-Emotional:** empathy stimulated by turn-taking. **Cognitive:** young children develop their understanding of space, speed and distances when sliding down quickly.



## Fireman's pole

**Physical:** coordination is supported when going down, as well as arm and core muscles. Landing strengthens bone density, which is built for life in early childhood. **Social-Emotional:** turn-taking and risk-taking. **Cognitive:** young children develop their understanding of space, speed and distances when gliding down fast.



## Tunnel

**Physical:** the children crawl through the tunnel, developing motor skills such as cross-body coordination and proprioception. **Social-Emotional:** turn-taking when passing each other.



## Faces panel

**Social-Emotional:** spurs group play and conversations with its two-sidedness. **Cognitive:** stimulates theory of mind: that others may have different feelings. Stimulates the understanding of symbols and facial expressions as symbols for emotions.



## Climbing net

**Physical:** supports physical strength and cross-body coordination, which impacts coordination of the right and left part of brain, fundamental for other skills such as the ability to read.

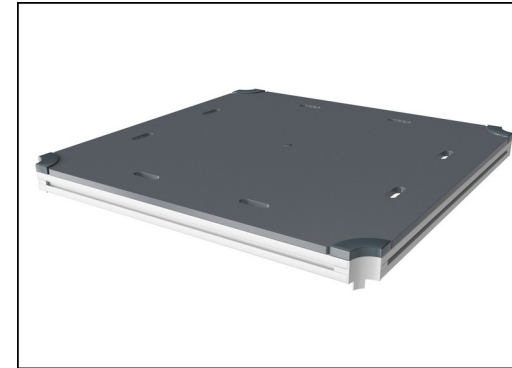

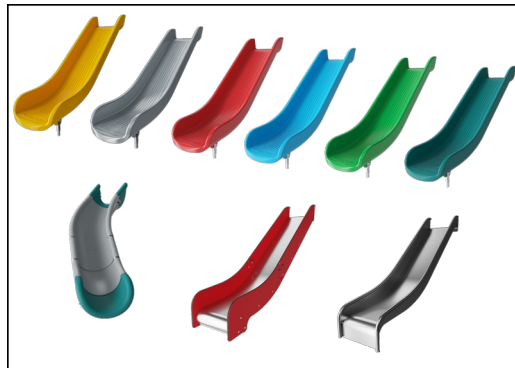

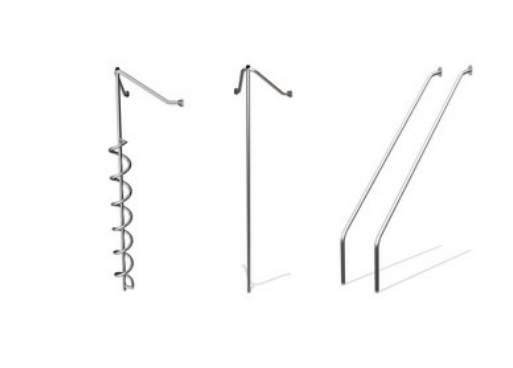


All decks are supported by unique designed low-carbon aluminum profiles with multiple attachment options. The grey colored molded decks are made of 75% post-consumer waste PP material with a non-skid pattern and texture surface.

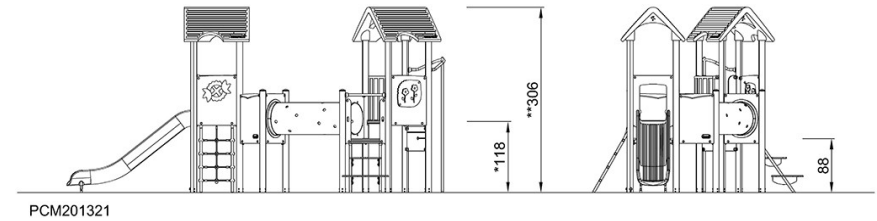
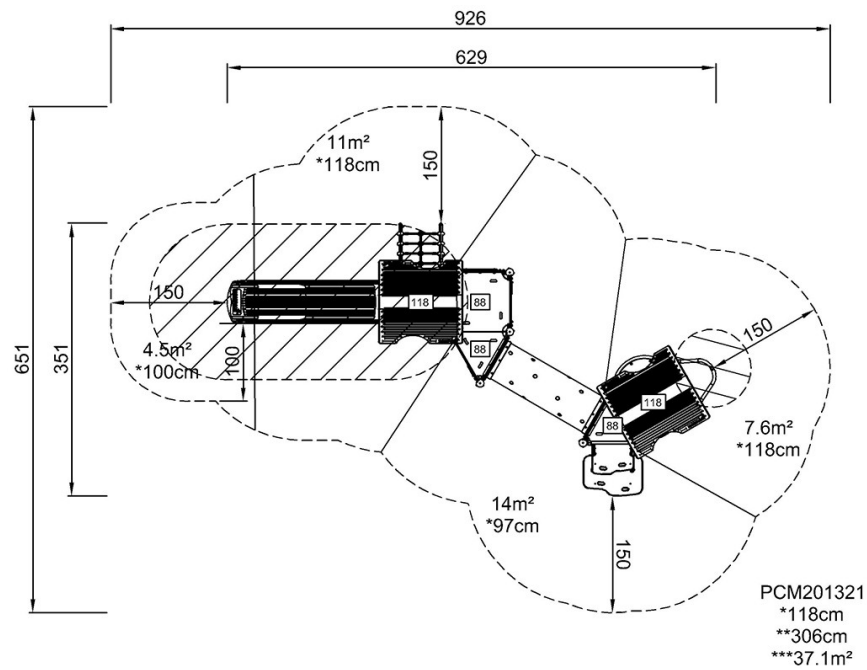
