

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The great amount of thrill and play value in the Triple Action Tower will encourage children to play again and again. The diverse climbing events and graded play add to the fun. Climbing the Pipe Ladder, Rock Climber or Climbing Wall trains arms and leg muscles, as well as cross-coordination. Cross-coordination stimulates cross-modal perception, necessary

for skills such as reading. Traversing the overhead ladder develops children's upper body muscles and arm strength. On all these climbing opportunities children learn about turn-taking, empathy, and cooperation. The plank bridge provides a great open view of the height, training the children's vestibular system when balancing across, while the cave bridge

encourages crawling and develops proprioception and spatial awareness. Climbing the tower can be rewarded by a thrilling glide down the Banister Bars, which trains the sense of balance.



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Banister bars

Physical: coordination is supported when going down, as well as arm and core muscles. Landing strengthens bone density, which is built for life in childhood. Social-Emotional: turn-taking and risk-taking.









Plank bridge

Physical: balancing across the plank develops the vestibular system as well as cross coordination. Social-Emotional: passing other children takes co-operation and teaches children turn-taking skills.



Pipe ladder

Physical: cross coordination and eye-hand coordination are supported when children climb the ladder. The climbing also supports leg and arm muscles. Social-Emotional: learning about turn taking and cooperation.



Overhead ladder

Physical: develops children's upper body muscles and arm strength, cross coordination and spatial awareness. This is especially important due to sedentary lifestyles and back-pain in children. Social-Emotional: chill and socialize on top of the overhead ladder, training cooperation.



Climbing wall

Physical: develops children's cross coordination, eye-hand coordination, and muscle strength when climbing. Social-Emotional: two-sided climb invites cooperation.



Rock climber

Physical: supports cross coordination and leg, arm and hand strength. Social-Emotional: the inclination makes climbing feel secure, especially for younger children.







Cave bridge

Physical: crawling in the cave bridge net develops cross-body coordination, proprioception and spatial awareness. Social-Emotional: cooperation and socializing with others in and around the net, turn-taking.







