Funnel

Social-Emotional: trains cooperation and turn-taking as children put materials into the funnel. Cognitive: the passing of materials through funnels supports the children's logical thinking and for younger children the understanding of object permanence: that materials don't vanish but run through at the other end.









Sand desk with bowl and sieve Social-Emotional: children can gather and store materials, cooperate and take a break together. Creative: sand can be shifted through the sieve, for understanding of cause and effect and object permanence.









Sand shovel Physical: develops dexterity and upper body muscles. Cognitive: understanding of object permanence, emptying and filling scoop.







Lower platform

Physical: climbing up, jumping down develops muscle and motor skills such as coordination, which are important in navigating your body securely through the world. Social-Emotional: children can sit and talk together. The step helps children who need extra height to maneuver the tap and water channel.
